Through their benefiting charities, Denver’s Road Home and Miracle on 19th Street, the proceeds raised by this annual event provide financial support and give hope to the homeless throughout the city. “By connecting people with a passion for helping others and a genuine concern for the homeless, the ultimate benefactors of this event are those truly in need.” says Lori Grunewald, Founding Member of the Foundation. “This event will entice people from around the area to gather for an evening rich in fun and excitement all in support of such a wonderful cause.”

Through the generous contributions and sponsorships of the attendees in 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007 the Foundation raised a record-breaking \$500,000 in support of the homeless and at-risk youth organizations. This year’s attendance is expected to draw 300 people with a goal of raising \$200,000.

Denver’s Road Home

Denver’s Road Home began in October 2003 in response to an increasing rise in homeless persons in the City & County of Denver and a mounting increase in public safety concerns. At that time, Mayor Hickenlooper convened a commission to develop and recommend a comprehensive plan seeking to address the root causes of homelessness and bring an end to homelessness for the Denver community. This plan is unique in its approach to not just serve the chronically homeless, but to offer opportunities and hope to all persons living on the street, in shelters or doubled up with friends and family in Denver, with a singular emphasis on persons and families whose incomes are at or below 30% area median income (those most in need and hardest to serve). www.denversroadhome.org

Miracle on 19th Street

For thirteen consecutive years, the Denver Chophouse together with the surrounding Denver community, has served Christmas dinner to the city's hungry and homeless. Together with local non-profits and the generous financial and volunteer support of community members, including PSI World, 2,500 homeless and displaced individuals are treated to a Christmas Day celebration. All guests are transported from area shelters via luxury coach to the ChopHouse where they are served a traditional holiday meal and receive a free flu shot, visit and gift bag from Santa.
